Travel ticket for all public transport services	It is already included in your student semester fee. When you pay 184,50 € for your matriculation (semester fee, not a tuition fee!), you will get your student card which is used also as a travel ticket. It is valid for all public transport services in Leipzig and surrounding areas for the period of your stay here.
